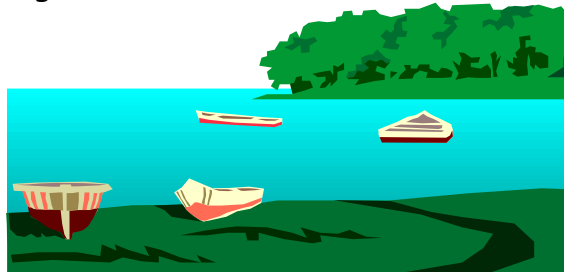


A DAY AT CHAUTAUQUA
