Rabbi Shnayer Leiman will be Young Israel Shomrai Emunah's Scholar in Residence for Shabbos Parashas Vayeshev, Dec. 19th-20th. Rabbi Leiman is Professor of Jewish History and Literature at Brooklyn College and Visiting Professor at the Revel Graduate School of Yeshiva University. Earlier, at Yale University, he administered undergraduate and



graduate Judaic studies programs.

Rabbi Leiman is a world-renowned and fascinating lecturer on historical, halakhic, and philosophical topics. He conducts tours of places of Jewish interest in Europe, contributes the "From the Pages of Tradition" column to the publication, *Tradition*, and has authored or co-authored many other articles and two books.
