Dr. Harry Jubas is a native of Czestochowa, one of Poland's largest flourishing prewar Jewish cities. At the outbreak of World War II Harry Jubas was a young boy who was forced with his Gerrer Hasidic family to move from the comfort of their home to the confines and harsh realities of the ghetto. Instead of being shot with a group of boys at an enforced roundup, he was selected to work at the local HASAG Perlcery Labor Camp. There he toiled and endured until his liberation in 1945. His personal compelling history of slave labor and survival amid the deaths of his parents and siblings is stirring.
