The recent domestic terrorist plot targeting synagogues in the Riverdale section of the Bronx is yet another reminder that Jewish institutions in the United States continue to be the subject of hostile surveillance and targets of attack. Case studies of terrorist attacks around the world have shown that most attacks are preceded by days, weeks, months, and in some instances, years of pre-operational surveillance by terrorists identifying and surveilling facilities and other targets for attack.

The Secure Community Network, in cooperation with the Department of Homeland Security, will be providing the organized Jewish community an opportunity to participate in a specially
