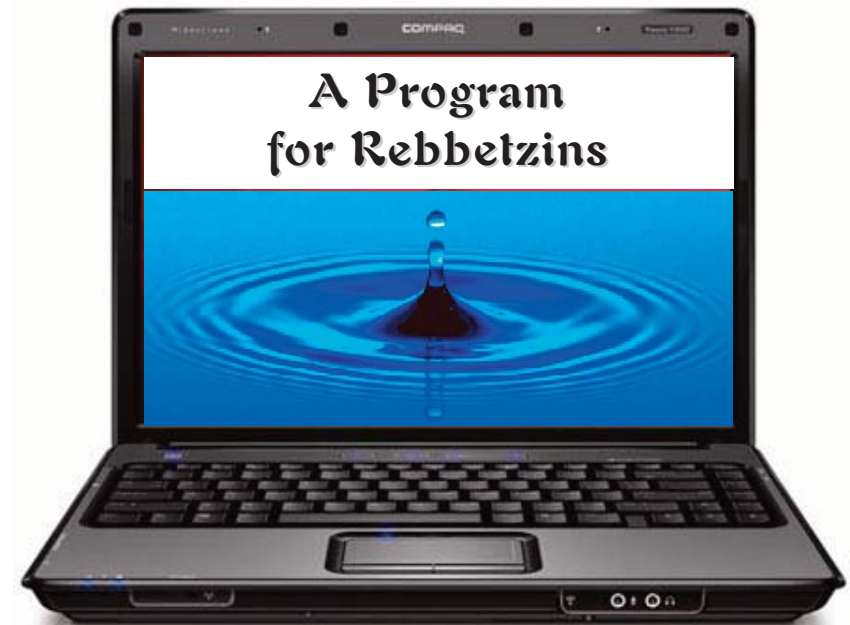

Goals & Objectives

The goals of this program, which is under the auspices of The National Council of Young Israel, are to train Rebbetzins to become Kallah teachers who can educate brides in the laws of Taharas Hamispacha and guide them through the typical issues that arise during the early stages of marriage.

The program will include:

- ◆ A thorough review of the laws of Taharas Hamishpacha
- ◆ Hashkafic insights into Taharas Hamishpacha and Shalom Bayis
- ◆ Basic teaching skills as they pertain to one-on-one instruction
- ◆ Different approaches for different types of Kallahs
- ◆ Guiding a Kallah through the engagement period and beginning of marriage
- ◆ Where to go for additional resources and how to ask specialized questions

Program Details

Participation is open to married women serving as Synagogue Rebbetzins (or those aspiring to become Synagogue Rebbetzins)

Program includes:

- ◆ 5 self-paced online lectures (password will be given upon acceptance of registration).
- ◆ Assignments and interactive class discussion via Young Israel Class blog (password protected) and final exam.
- ◆ Optional follow-up conference call sessions for questions and discussion of material
